Online Deadline for all yearbooks orders and completed 5th Grade Ads is
Friday, October 30th

The quantity of Yearbooks ordered from the Publishing Company each year is based on the number of pre-orders we receive plus an additional 10%. The only way to guarantee that your child will receive a yearbook in May is to pre-order one before the **October 30, 2009** deadline.

A **Yearbook Student Ad** (is the 5th Grade Ad that includes a Photo with a Dedication message) and a **Guess Who Baby Picture** (the Add-on option available at check out) are for **5TH GRADE STUDENTS ONLY.**

Please be aware if you place an order for a Yearbook Student Ad or a Guess Who Baby Picture Add-on for a student who is not in 5th Grade, you will need to request a refund from MyYear.com directly. There is a \$5 fee for refunds.

A **Dedication** (an 18 word, text ONLY message) is available for Kindergarten-5th Grade as an Add-on Option.

The Contest Prizes:

2. The winning class/classes will also earn a free "2010 Catching the Wave of the Future" yearbook as a gift for their homeroom teacher.

The Contest Rules:

1. Students without siblings attending CWE who are purchasing multiple books for himself/herself will count only as 1book purchased/per homeroom class. (example: Student ordered 2 books for himself/herself and one as a gift for a grandparent = only 1 book for teacher A's classroom)
2. Families with siblings enrolled at CWE purchasing multiple books will count as 1 book per purchase/per student's homeroom class for each book purchased. (example: Family ordered 3 books for 3 different students = 1book for teacher B's class, 1book for teacher C's class & 1book for teacher D's class)
3. Students purchasing a book for himself and another book as a gift for a friend attending CWE will count as 1 book purchased per student/per each student's homeroom class (Example: Both students are in teachers X's classroom = 2 books for teacher X's class, One student is in teacher X's class and one student is in teacher Y's class = 1 book for teacher X's class & 1 book for teacher Y's class)
4. Books purchased now until October 30, 2009 from either online or on campus will count toward the Pre-Sale Contest. Books purchased after October 30, 2009 will not be counted toward the contest.
5. Yearbook classroom sales totals will be displayed starting in early October for the students to see their class' progress. The names of who has or who has not purchased a yearbook will NOT be revealed in the contest display.
